

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to the "Noncoal Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act" and the "Clean Streams Law" **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Bedrock Quarries, Inc., 2052 Lucon Road, P.O. Box 79, Skippack, PA 19474, has made an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) to revise Noncoal Surface Mining Permit #64940302 to include a request for a permit boundary correction to remove 20.4 acres of existing permit area to the north of the existing pit and replace it with 20.4 acres of new permit area to the west of the existing pit. The mine site is located in Damascus Township, Wayne County and is known as Bedrock Quarry. The permit area is and will remain 98.0 acres. The permit area is situated at 1211 Oregon Turnpike (PA S.R. 1003), Damascus, PA. The Galilee, PA U.S.G.S. 7.5 minute topographic map contains the area described. A copy of the application is available for public inspection at the Damascus Township Municipal Building located at 60 Conklin Hill Road, Damascus, PA. Office hours are Monday through Thursday between the hours of 7:00 AM and 2:30 PM and Friday between the hours of 8:00 AM and 11:30 AM. Written comments, objections, or a request for an informal conference or public hearing may be submitted to the PADEP, Pottsville District Mining Office, 5 West Laurel Boulevard, Pottsville, PA 17901-2522, up to and including thirty (30) days after the fourth publication of this notice, or no later than Sunday, April 29, 2018. The written correspondence must include the person's name, address, telephone number, and a brief statement as to the nature of the objection(s).
