

What Can be Recycled at the Damascus Township Building, Wayne County PA

60 Conklin Hill Rd. • 2nd Saturday of every month, 9AM-12 Noon



GLASS BOTTLES

Empty and rinse. Labels may stay on.

Separate by colors - clear, brown, & green (all wine bottles are green)

DO NOT BREAK GLASS.



Windows, mirrors, light bulbs, white glass, dishes, drinking glasses, Pyrex, heat tempered glass, or ceramics.



METAL CANS

Empty and rinse. Labels may stay on.



Do not include with metal cans:

Pie plates, foil, paint cans, aerosol cans,

pots and pans, fuel tanks, coat hangers, or other metal items.



PLASTIC BOTTLES WITH SCREW TOPS/LIDS ONLY

Empty and rinse.

Milk, soda, water & detergent bottles



Do not include with plastic bottles:

Plastic bags, tubs, vegetable trays, toys, or other plastic items.

No #3, #4, #5, #6, or #7.

No styrofoam.

No motor oil bottles.



Cardboard, Newspapers, Magazines, Phone Books, Junk Mail

Must be separated by type. Tie with heavy string or twine only.

Do Not Use Any Plastic.

Volunteers are there to help, but not to separate your trash.

Please wait your turn to drive up close to the bins so as to keep everyone safe!

Just because an item is marked **RECYCLABLE** does **NOT** mean it is recyclable under our program!
